The information reported below meets the reporting requirements under Section 18004(e) of the Coronavirus Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act).

1. Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) acknowledges that the institution has signed and returned Department of Education the Certification and Agreement. EFSC intends to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. EFSC will receive \$4,408,181.00 pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
3. EFSC distributed \$515,279.25 as of December 31, 2020.
4. EFSC estimates that 9,844 students in the Spring 2020, Summer 2020, and Fall 2020 terms are eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 based on Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) submissions.
5. As of December 31, 2020, 9,232 students received Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under final rule: 1) limited eligibility to students in Title IV programs under Section 481 in the Higher Education Act of 1965 and 2) required students whose applications were selected by the Department of Education to complete the verification process be eligible for CARES Grants of \$25 per class were disbursed to eligible students in Spring 2020, Summer 2020, and
